MAYORS TWO YEAR AGENDA

REJUVENATION OF THE VILLAGE OF SPRING VALLEY

1. **Spring Valley Street Repairs** – All the streets of Spring Valley will be repaired. This will include paving all sidewalks and curbs.
2. **Main Street from Dr. Berg to Route 59** – All sidewalks and curbs repaired. All building facades will be repaired/renovated this will include brick facing and/or stucco. New lighting along street.
3. **Memorial Park** – The park will be completely renovated. Renovations shall include;
 - a. Complete landscaping renovation of the park shrubbery and pond will be raised three (3) feet;
 - b. Floral arrangements around the park;
 - c. Restoration of the Sports Programs - Renovation of the field to allow for a complete sports complex (Soccer, Football, Baseball, Cricket);
 - d. Construction of two (2) public bathrooms located downstairs from the Darden Center.
4. **Bus Stop Parking Lot** – Creation of a new building with bathrooms for commuter access. Space will be provided for appropriate business to rent.
5. **Louis Kurtz Civic Center**- Complete renovation of the building and replacement of the roof. The Civic Center will become one of the jewels of the Village. The Center will be incorporated under the Parks and Recreation Department.
6. **Signage** – All signs on Main Street will be made visible and clear to understand (Parking Meters and Signs).

7. **Security Cameras** – Security cameras will be installed where needed throughout the Village.
8. **Purchase of 4 new buses.**
9. **Purchase of 3 Garbage Trucks** – To ensure a cleaner Spring Valley and to save money, we will purchase 3 Garbage Trucks. We can no longer allow garbage to pile up on our streets
10. **Additional housing for the community** – I have a plan to build 3 more complex's similar to Sycamore Crest (11 Summit Avenue)

This item will be subject to board approval: Mayor shall have final decision making authority on all renovation projects and employment matters on behalf of the Village.

It will be necessary for a bond issuance of 5 Million dollars to effectuate the renovation plans over the next 2 years
